THE TRANSIT WARRANTY



Transit Truck Bodies Inc. (Transit) warrants your truck body against all manufacturing defects according to the specifications below.

1 YEAR

For a period of 1 year from the date of purchase: installation, floors, doors, interior finish, tie bars, fenders, bumpers, ramps, mirrors, electricity, hardware, LED lights, back-up cameras.

3 YEARS

For a period of 3 years from the date of purchase: water infiltration and paint adhesion.

3 YEARS OR UP TO 60,000 KM / 37,500 MILES

For a period of 3 year or 60,000 km / 37,500 miles from the date of purchase: modification of the wheelbase of the vehicle.

5 YEARS

For a period of 5 years from the date of purchase: substructure, roof, adhesion of panels, rear frames as well as against all perforations of aluminum components, LED lights (parts only).

EXCLUSIONS

Installation by Transit of goods produced by third parties

Transit offers no warranty on installed equipment that was manufactured by another company. The applicable warranty will be that of the manufacturer. This is the case for items such as liftgates and heating units. The installation of these elements is guaranteed for 1 year. Transit will assist the customer in contacting the manufacturer to exercise the warranty.

Use of subcontractor

Any options installed through a subcontractor will be warranted by that subcontractor. This is the case for items such as : refrigeration units, heating units, upfittings, floors covered with Line-X, generators.

CONDITIONS

- This warranty applies to normal use and does not apply to damage caused by accident, abuse, neglect, or improper maintenance.
- The truck body must be cleared of snow during winter to limit the weight of the snow.
- The truck body must have undergone the recommended maintenance and prevention
- Repairs must be carried out at our factory located in Laval or at a service center authorized by Transit.

RECOMMENDED MAINTENANCE AND PREVENTION

Vertical Roll-up Door: The door should be lubricated monthly with a non-penetrating lubricant. Do not use grease. Warning: To avoid breaking the rear doors, never drive with the doors open.

The maintenance and use of the tailgate must be carried out according to the manufacturer's instructions, as indicated in the owner's manual. Improper maintenance may cause damage and void the warranty.

To prevent deterioration of the floor, avoid moving the merchandise by sliding it on the floor, as well as transporting wet material in a truck body that does not have an aluminum or corundum floor.

The mounting bolts (U-Bolts or other types) must be checked and tightened every 20,000 km / 12,500 miles.

SERIAL NUMBER OF YOUR TRUCK BODY

Your serial number is located on the front of the truck body, on the passenger side, stamped on the bottom rub rail. The serial number is also on the certification label affixed to the inside of the driver's side chassis door.
